



APPLICATION FOR FIH MEMBERSHIP

Documents required to apply for FIH Membership

According to FIH Statutes articles 2.2 (b) iii & viii, 2.3 (c), 2.4 (b) & (d), 4.1 (c) and 4.2, summarised below:

1. The Constitution or Statutes of the National Association, which must substantially follow the template provided by FIH. The compulsory articles (being articles 2.1, 2.2 and 2.3 of the FIH template) must be included;
2. That the applicant has the Sanctioned and Unsanctioned Events Regulations, and the Anti-Corruption Regulations in place (these Rules and Regulations are available on the FIH website);
3. The names, addresses and genders of its officers;
4. Where possible, the number of clubs/schools/other sporting units, etc. of its members;
5. An endorsement or confirmation by its National Olympic Committee (NOC) or Sports Ministry (or equivalent body, being the highest national authority for sport in that country), that the applicant is the body solely responsible for governing hockey for men and women in that country;
6. A declaration that it has applied for membership of its Continental Federation (CF);
7. A declaration that it is solvent, or a confirmation by its NOC or Sports Ministry of its financial viability or that it has the resources to run its hockey activities.
